

International Packing List

This packing list serves as a guide. **Please label all clothing with your camper's FULL NAME**. Campers will launder their own clothes once per 2 week session locally with the assistance of counselors. Please label all clothing. Avoid bringing expensive clothing articles or ones that require special laundering. SMA is not responsible for lost or damaged personal items.

Clothing

5-6 shorts

5-6 T-shirts/tank tops (at least 1 that is tech / quick dry for the river)

1 long sleeve tech / quick dry shirt for the river

1 long pants

1 pair sweatpants

1 sweatshirt

1 warm jacket or fleece

1 poncho or raincoat

6 pair underwear

6 pair socks

1 pair pajamas

2 bathing suits

Sun Hat

Headlamp w/ extra batteries

Required Items: Camper must have these items for every activity!

Reusable Water Bottle

Day Pack: Should be big enough to pack water bottle, beach towel, sunscreen and other miscellaneous items. Please label the pack with your child's name.

Toilet Articles

Toiletry Bag/Shower Caddy

Toothbrush/Toothpaste

Body soap or soap dish

Shampoo/Conditioner

Brush/Comb

Deodorant

Optional Items

Books / Journal

Photos from home

Musical instruments

Stationery/stamps

Favorite stuffed animal

Footwear

2 pair sneakers or trail shoes

Flip-flops

1 pair of sandals with straps that will stay on in the water

(Chacos, Tevas, Keens, etc.)

*These are required to go White Water Rafting and Canoeing

As part of the International All-Inclusive package SMA will provide:

- Towels for the lake and for the shower
- Linens, pillow, and blankets
- Sleeping bag & pad for camping overnights

DO NOT BRING: Tablets, E-Readers, and other expensive electronic devises. We encourage your child to travel with a mobile phone. Once you child arrives at camp mobile phones will be stored in camp office safe. Cameras, iPods, other electronics, jewelry, and items of sentimental value that you cannot afford to lose should be left at home.

Communication: You child will contact you when they arrive safely at camp. Your camper may receive or make phone calls once during each 2 week session. Campers may receive one email per week, text only. Please send e-mails to: Jud@sma-summers with your child's name in the subject line. Of course, you are always welcome to contact us for an update or to verify that your camper arrived safely at camp.

Medications: Any non-over-the-counter medications need to be turned over to camp office upon arrival. Please send enough for camper's entire stay.



International Packing List

International Camper Travel Information:

- Our international campers arrive and depart from Dulles International Airport in Washington DC on the opening and closing days of the sessions.
- Please DO NOT ship your child's luggage to camp.
- We provide a van service that is included in the International Camper All-Inclusive Package.
- Please have your child travel with a mobile phone so we can stay in communication.
 - Please note that mobile phones will be kept in the camp office once the session begins and that your camper will not have access to them.
- Our experienced staff will meet your child outside of customs and immigration.
- Please e-mail a photo of your camper so our staff know who look for at Dulles International Airport.
- Upon arrival in the US, your camper should use the following address on all immigration forms:

- Our SMA Staff will be wearing matching SMA Camp Staff T-shirts.
- Our SMA Staff or your child will call you when we meet your camper at Dulles International Airport.
- Once our staff have gathered all the campers, they travel back to camp together on the SMA Camp Van.

If Your Child Is a Traveling as An Unaccompanied Minor:

- Unaccompanied Minors are children deemed by the airlines as too young to travel without an escort.
- Each airline has their own fees and policies regarding unaccompanied minors.
- The airlines will require that you designate one of our camp employees as the responsible adult who will assume custody of your child at Dulles Airport upon their arrival.
- A representative from the airline will escort your child off the plane and accompany them through immigration, baggage collection, and customs.
- Our camp employee will get a security pass to meet the airline representative and the unaccompanied minor (your child), at which time the airline will release the child to our supervision.
- From there, our staff person will take your child to meet the other campers arriving that day.
