What is an auction?

An auction is a system of buying and selling goods or services by offering them for bidding—allowing people to bid and sell to the highest bidder.

Auction Terminology

“as-is where-is”

The item sold in its present condition, with no return privileges.

“Lot”

Item(s) up for auction. An auctioneer can announce one lot number or multiple lot numbers.

“So much a piece times the money.”

The auctioneer asks the winning bidder to choose how many of the like items they want to be multiplied by the winning bid amount.

“Option”

The winning bidder can choose how many of the items being sold they want. The items MUST be selected in numeric order.

“Group”

Multiple lots are sold for one price. The winning bidder will receive all items within the grouped lots.

“Pass”

If an item is up for auction and there are no bids or the bidding does not start at a number deemed acceptable by the auctioneer, the item will be passed.

“Buyers Premium”

A fee that Centurion Service Group charges for conducting an auction.

“Proxy Bid/Absentee Bid”

Allows a bidder to place a bid without being present for the auction. A bidder will submit the maximum price they are willing to pay for an item and allow Centurion Service Group to bid on their behalf, up to the maximum bid amount. In addition, Centurion Service Group does not start bids at the maximum bid price.

How to Create an Account and Register Online

Step 1:

Create your login account at bid.centurionservice.com
Once you've created your account, you will not have to create another account again in the future.

Once signed in, click the "Register to Bid" button to the right of the auction of your choice. You must first register for each auction of your choice before participating.

- Existing good-standing bidders
 - Once you have agreed to our terms of sale and registered, you will be automatically approved for the auction of your choice.
- New bidders
 - You will need to agree to our terms of sale and provide a deposit of \$2000. Once this is done, Centurion's auction manager will review your pending registration for auction approval.

You will receive an email notification once you are approved for bidding. Once approved, you can begin placing bids.

Timed auctions are auctions that take place online over a period of time and close at the end of designated time, i.e., one week. You will be able to place your bids until the auction is closed.



Account and Registration FAQ

HOW AND WHEN DO I REGISTER TO BID AT AN AUCTION?

You can register for auctions at bid.centurionservice.com. Bidders may pre-register and are encouraged to do so as soon as new auctions are posted.

Important Tip: Register Early! New bidders will need to allow enough time for approval. Registering in advance of the auction closing will ensure you will be approved to bid in time for the auction. Please note: if you register the day of the auction, you may not receive immediate approval.

WHAT IS NEEDED TO PARTICIPATE IN AN ONLINE AUCTION?

Centurion requires a valid driver's license, state ID, or passport for first-time bidders. Your ID can be uploaded when registering for our auctions.

IS THERE A COST TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN AN AUCTION?

New bidders will hold a one-time \$2000 deposit for 90 days or until in good standing with Centurion Service Group. Once this period is complete, the deposit will be released back to the bidder or applied to the bidder's final invoice if they choose to withdrawal from Centurion auctions.
