Please regard this letter as confirmation of an approval of a freight container examination scheme / programme for Titan Containers A/S, Europa Trading Centre, London Road, Grays, Essex, RM20 4DB – their approval registration number is **GB -158**.

This approval, under the terms of the Freight Container (Safety Convention) Regulations 1984 has been awarded to Titan Containers A/S by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) as Great Britain's national regulator for health and safety.

As part of our consideration for approval which was updated in July 2017, Titan Containers A/S agreed:

- That all examinations carried out on a container pursuant to this approval shall be in accordance with the requirements described in the document entitled 'Conditions for approval of examination schemes or programmes', and
- That any markings made / decal affixed on or near the Safety Approval Plate will carry the registration number **GB – 158**

This approval allows Titan Containers A/S. to operate under either a Periodic Examination Scheme (PES) or an Approved Continuous Examination Programme (ACEP).

The registration number does not appear on the Global ACEP Database because as an Administration responsible for ACEP registrations, HSE does not currently publish a list of all valid ACEPs for any organisation.

I can confirm that Titan Containers A/S do hold a valid ACEP registration **GB-158**.
