## K & J to Stay Out of New Jersey Moving Forward

New Jersey has a crazy tax law where if we drive even ONE MILE in that state, they charge approximately \$4000 in taxes or fees. We just don't run enough miles in the state to justify that cost, so we've told our shippers that we aren't going there. For those who occasionally get over in that direction, this is a note and reminder to you steer clear of NJ. We're sorry for all the NJ lovers in the fleet!

#### **Major Accident Reductions in 2020**

Congratulations, Kudos, Awesome Job and the list of commendations goes on.....

There was a reduction of incidents that involved K & J Trucking units by 32.9%. There were 85 incidents/accidents in 2019 which includes everything from damaged trailers, suicidal deer, us being hit or us hitting others. The total for 2020 came to 57 incidents/accidents. What a super job done by all of you. But, there is still room for improving these statistics.

## Accidents reduced by 32.9 % year over year.

In 2019 there were 44 of the 85 where we were at fault. That includes not finding the damages on the trailers until getting to the next facility to backing in and hitting someone or something else. That is a 51.7% at-fault rate for 2019. In 2020 there are 25 of the 57 that could have been prevented. That is a 43% at fault rate for us.

The reduction in the incidents/accidents helped with our insurance renewals but there is room for improvement. The tough part is we don't see improvement in the insurance costs right away. We need to ensure that there is a continued downward trend in incidents.

Seeing the improvement in us being at fault is great. The continued use of 6 second following distances and the "get out and look" has helped. Keep it up everyone. Our most expensive accidents are the hitting someone at road speeds 1.7%. The most frequent are backing into someone or something else 28%.
