Boston While Black is leading in shaping a city where Black people want to live and work because they have the spaces, tools, and relationships to find their tribe, grow their network, navigate the city, and have fun.

The inaugural How to Boston While Black Summit is 2.5 days of workshops, panels, and experiences highlighting the challenges and solutions to navigating Boston as a Black professional, student, and entrepreneur.

The goal of the summit is to bring together the people committed to making Boston more welcoming & accessible through targeted programs, resources, and community-building. This will create more engaged residents who want to stay and contribute to the fabric of Boston.

The summit will include a special half-day pre-conference on building a thriving and connected Black tech and life sciences ecosystem across the region. Speakers throughout the summit will share best practices for navigating the civic, political, professional, entrepreneurial, cultural, and social landscapes of Greater Boston as a Black person.







### **BOSTON IS A HUB FOR EDUCATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITY**

- Boston is one of the country's leading medical, academic, and technology hubs.
- For tech degree completions, Boston was No. 3, behind only Washington, D.C. and New York.
- In 2019, Boston was ranked as the best city for college students in the U.S. Higher education students comprise 20% of the Boston population.

### HOWEVER, BOSTON HAS YET TO CREATE ENOUGH SPACES WHERE BLACK PEOPLE CAN THRIVE

- Black students report they feel the city has a lot to offer when it comes to their education and careers, but they feel disconnected when it comes to finding a real sense of community.
- Black and Latino people make up more than a fifth of the state's population, but own just over 3% of businesses with employees.
- Very few Black people rise to leadership positions in nearly every industry in Boston, perpetuating the city's multi-thousand dollar racial wealth gap and leading to almost no Black middle-class neighborhoods.
