

# **Quick Reference Guide**

# Lyric

#### **Basic Functions**

Press the 'Home' for button below the touchscreen to return to the Home screen from other functions.



### The Security Menu will show the following options

 Security features
 ♥ on the Home screen

 Arm in Stay mode
 ♥ and enter a user code

 Arm in Away mode
 ♥ and enter a user code

> Press and hold this button below the touchscreen. Then press:

n or so or local on the touchscreen

### **Arming the System**

The Home button beneath the screen lights green when the system is ready to be armed.

#### To Arm

Delay

Panic

Arm Away

Press the *arm away* button and enter your 4 digit user code. This is used for times when no one is home and all perimeter and interior zones are

protected.

Arm Stay Press the *arm stay* button and enter your 4 digit user code. This is for times

when the house is occupied but only protects perimeter zones (doors).

Arm No Press the *arm stay* button. Then press *'Entry Delay'* (on the blue bar) to *OFF*.

This is used for times when the home is occupied and protects perimeter

zones and interior motion sensors are deactivated.

Quick Arm Press to arm the system in any mode without needing to enter a user code.

This needs to be enabled by Custom Alarm. A user code is ALWAYS needed

to disarm the system.

#### To Disarm

Touch the *Disarm* button, enter your 4-digit user code. The system beeps and announces "Disarmed" (or will beep if voice is not activated).

## **Bypassing Sensors or Zones**

Bypassing allows arming the system while intentionally leaving selected zones unprotected. Bypassed zones will NOT trigger an alarm. Please note; Fire, CO and Panic zones CANNOT be bypassed.

## To Bypass a Zone

Before arming the system, press *Zones* on the Security menu. A list of your system's zones appears. Faulted or (open) zones are shown in red or orange. Use the up and down arrows to scroll through the list of zones. Select the zone to be bypassed and press the *Bypass* button at the bottom of the screen. A keypad will appear. Enter your 4 digit user code. The zone list reappears with the Bypass icon shown for the affected zone.

Press back arrow or home button to return back to the Security screen. System will show "Ready to Arm-Bypass" on top of screen.

Keep in mind, the process of bypassing a sensor only lasts until the system is disarmed next, then the process has to be repeated on the next arming.

## **User and Security Codes**

On the Home Screen, press Security.

Press Tools, and enter the Master User Code.

Select Users. Existing Users are displayed, along with the Guest and Duress code listings. Four asterisk (\*\*\*\*) appear on each listing that has a security code already established.

#### Add new user code

Press Add New and a new user screen appears.

You can change the user number and enter text of a person's name. Then enter a 4 digit code for that user. Press 'Save' in the bottom right corner.

#### Deleting a user code

Select the listed user

At the bottom of the screen, press *Delete* and then *Yes*. Press *'Save'* in the bottom right corner.

#### **Enable Door Chime**

The Lyric can give audible notifications when a protected door opens while the system is disarmed. This can be used to know when a zone such as a perimeter door is opened.

On the Home Screen, select *Settings*. Select *Chime* to enable chime sounds or *Voice* to activate voice. Adjust the volume with the slider and press *Save*.

## **Adjusting Keypad Volume & Brightness**

Adjust voice and system sounds with the Volume slider. System sounds include zone alert chimes and countdown beeps.


Adjust touchscreen brightness with the Brightness slider.

Press 'Clean' before cleaning the touchscreen. Lyric hides the controls and counts down 15 seconds. During this time, a soft, damp cloth can be used on the screen without affecting the controls.

#### To View or Join Available Wi-Fi Networks

On the Home Screen, press Security.

Press the *Tools Menu*, Enter User Code, press the *Wi-Fi Config* button. A list of Wi-Fi options appears.



Press *Scan Access Points*. A list of available networks is displayed. Use the up and down arrows to select the desired network and press *Edit*. The network information is displayed.

If a password is required, press *Password Key* and enter the password.

Press the Save button and then Join.
