

Time Bank Local Application (TBLA)

Technical Requirements

Time Bank Local Application (TBLA) was designed so it can be installed and run within an existing infrastructure so that additional hardware expenditures are not needed. TBLA is required to run the Time Bank Online link as a scheduled event. You can use the application of your choice to schedule the task.

The following Microsoft components are available for download from the Microsoft website (www.microsoft.com under downloads section) if you would like to install them prior to the installation of Time Bank.

- Windows Installer 4.5
- .NET Framework v4

System Requirements

Prerequisites

Each of the prerequisite software programs will be installed as part of the Time Bank installation if not currently installed.

1. *Microsoft .NET Framework v 4
2. *Windows Installer v 4.5

* Note that a reboot is typically required if Microsoft .NET Framework and/or Windows installer needs to be installed.

Minimum PC Requirements

Total Memory: 1GB or more of memory

Processor: 1.2GHZ Processor or above

Supported Operating Systems: MS-Windows 10 and later except S mode
MS-Windows 2016 Server and later

Time Bank does not support non-windows operating systems

Connections: Internet access is required to download the Time Bank application and configuration data.
