

Vaccine Incentive Program Risks

Nearly half of employers, HR professionals and business attorneys say they have already decided against a vaccine mandate, according to a new [survey](#) of 1,800 executives conducted by *Little Law Firm*. Most of the companies surveyed by *Little* are also worried that employees may push back on a mandate and how a vaccine mandate could affect company culture. Instead, most employers said they planned to provide vaccine information to their workers, and nearly a third said they would offer paid time off for workers to get the shot.
