APPLY TO ECAP

You can perform a self-evaluation to see if you meet the eligibility requirements. [CLICK HERE](#)

ECAP evaluates your transcripts and accepts you into their program

Create your TEA account & create your Certify Teacher account

Enroll in the Study Plan Tracker in Certify Teacher to track your progress. Take a practice exam in Certify Teacher based on your core subject to establish a benchmark. Aim for a score of 270

Concentrate on the areas that your test results indicate you need further review in

Once you score 270 on your review test, ECAP will give you permission to take your Content Test

You should study for your PPR test during your first year of teaching

GET HIRED TO TEACH IN THE CLASSROOM

ECAP advisor will attend a number of classroom visits to help you

Complete 150 hrs in the classroom. This completes your required 300 hrs of training

Study for PPR test

Take ECAP's PPR review course

Follow ECAP advisors advice. You need their approval to obtain your standard certificate
