I. JOB PURPOSE

Operate computer-controlled machine centers to perform one or more machine functions.

II. KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Adjust machine feed and speed, change cutting tools, or adjust machine controls when automatic programming is faulty or if machine malfunctions
- Calculate machine speed and feed ratios, and size and position of cuts
- Clean and maintain machines, tooling, and parts to maintain equipment in optimal production condition
- Insert control instructions into machine control units to start operation
- Lift work pieces, fixtures, and vices to machine manually or with hoist or crane
- Listen to machines during operation to detect sounds such as those made by dull cutting tools or excessive vibration and adjust machines to fix any problems
- Measure dimensions of finished work pieces to ensure conformance to specifications, using precision measuring instruments, templates and fixtures
- Modify cutting programs to account for problems encountered during operation and save modified programs
- Mount, install, align, and secure tools, attachments, fixtures and work pieces on machines using hand tools and precision measuring instruments
- Remove and replace dull cutters
- Stop machines to remove finished work pieces, or to change tooling, setup, or work piece placement according to machining sequences

- Work safely to prevent on-the-job injuries following all safety regulations
- Work with programmers to troubleshoot manufacturing problems
- Must adhere to all company policies
- Must have a basic understanding of quality management systems related to ISO 13485
- Must have a basic understanding of Work Instructions and their related data collection documents (e.g. run sheets)
