Diamond Logistics Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

During 2020 and 2021 we have been reviewing our carbon emissions and ways in which we can support with immediate carbon reduction and furthermore reducing our carbon output to achieve net zero by 2050.

We work with our carrier partners; DHL, DPD, Hermes, Royal Mail to offset carbon emissions for our parcel deliveries through the overnight and international networks.

Measures to date taken within our fulfilment centres include replacing and refreshing our packaging to avoid using plastics that are non-recyclable and use recyclable cardboard packaging including boxes, water based gum tape and paper void fill.

Within our sameday service offering we promote a co-load and back-load service to ensure our vehicles are always carrying goods on board and not travelling empty. We also run a dedicated shared service to city centres picking up from multiple clients and delivering by end of day to avoid multiple runs to the same city on a same day service.

Within our offices we operate and promote energy saving measures including automatic lighting in shared communal areas, installation of LED ceiling tile lights within the offices, a turn off the lights and heating policy on exit and we have recycling receptacles available throughout.

All company cars are now electric.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next nine years to 112 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 5%

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Offset our current carbon footprint
- Analysis of current suppliers and change as required
- Reduce plastic waste and increase reusable containers and materials
- Increase participation in tree planting initiatives
- Invest in further automatic lighting
