<u>Slide 1:</u> This is the introductory slide – it will show the parents and carers in your school some examples of what their App will look like when they have downloaded and logged in.

<u>Slide 2:</u> Show your parents and carers the introductory video on this slide. It will give them a brief overview of what they have access to with Safer Schools NI.

<u>Slide 3:</u> Accessible on desktop and within the App, your parents and carers can also use our Online Safety Centre. This gives guidance on how to block, report, mute and set privacy/parental settings on a range of various platforms. For parents and carers of younger children, it also gives guidance on giving your child their first phone.

<u>Slide 4:</u> This slide will show your parents and carers how to access the Online Safety Centre from their App and how to navigate around it.

<u>Slide 5:</u> The Safer Schools NI App will alert your parents and carers to risks, threats and online trends that may affect their children and young people. As a school, you can also harness this push notification technology to send school related updates._This slide will give them an example of each.

<u>Slide 6:</u> Your Safer Schools NI App is customisable. Parents and carers will have access to school news, policies, calendar, social media and other learning platforms such as Class Dojo and SeeSaw. This slide will show them where these sections of the App are situated and how to access them.

The Home Learning Hub contains PowerPoints, lesson plans, worksheets and activities on topics such as image sharing, trusted adults, bullying, fake news and more.

<u>Slide 10, 11 & 12:</u> These three slides will show your parents and carers how to create an account, log in to their school using the login or QR codes provided to them. Slide 12 will also show you them how to add another school to their account – this is useful if they have a number of children who attend different schools.
