Requirements


Facebook Requirements:

• If streaming from a Facebook page, you need to be an admin or editor of that page

Zoom Requirements:

- A Licensed Zoom account
- Enable Custom Live Streaming

Zoom Meeting In a second browser window, open your Zoom Dashboard

and schedule a meeting for your event date.


Once you've created the meeting, copy in the 3 items from Facebook to the Zoom meeting's Configure Custom Streaming Service window (found at the bottom of the page).

Configure Custom Streaming Service Enter the streaming URL

Configure live stream during the meeting

Note: Facebook uses different terminology. Here are Facebook's terms and their equivalent in Zoom:

Facebook	Zoom
Server URL	Stream URL
Stream key	Stream key
Event URL	Live streaming page URL




Go to Set Up Live Video. You'll need these 3 items from your scheduled live video event.

page, go to Create and click Live. Then create a

your Zoom stream into Buzzlt.






Go back to your Facebook window and go to Stream settings. Go to Embed live video and click Get embed code.



Click Copy Embed Code.


