
YouTube Requirements:

- Enable Custom Live Streaming








In a second browser window, open your Zoom Dashboard and schedule a meeting for your event date.

Once you've created the meeting, copy in the 3 items from YouTube to the Zoom meeting's Configure Custom Streaming Service window (found at the bottom of the page).

GO LIVE to create a scheduled livestream.




YouTube will carry your Zoom stream into Buzzlt.









Open the live streaming page URL from above in another browser window, click the SHARE button beneath the video, and select the Embed option.






Copy the livestream





Go to your Buzzlt event home page and click the blue button in the bottom right. Turn on the **Livestream** feature.

Now click the blue **Livestream Config** button and **add your** livestream embed link in the URL setting. Now your attendees will be able to watch the livestream on Buzzlt.
