Now, as you have just received our offer/Angebot, the next step is to hand this in to your job advisor (Arbeitsvermittler:in) and get their approval for covering the tuition fees by issuing a Bildungsgutschein (BGS).

A Bildungsgutschein is an educational voucher provided by the Agentur für Arbeit/Jobcenter to people registered in Germany who are unemployed or soon to be.

Arrange a visit or a call with your local Agentur für Arbeit/Jobcenter in order to discuss your individual case with your job advisors. They will tell you whether or not you meet the criteria for being granted a BGS.

The main aim of the Agentur für Arbeit/Jobcenter is to help you sustainably integrate yourself back into labour. They are only willing to invest their money in your education, if they believe their investment will be worth it.

Therefore, it is exceptionally important to showcase why you want to take our course as well as what your future plans are.

- Demonstrate high motivation and that you are aiming to complete further training to find work in the respected field.
- Actively put your career goals into relation with the program you will be going through.

- ask you job advisor for a written refusal (schriftliche Ablehnung)
- as soon as you have received the written statement, please forward it to one of our admissions managers

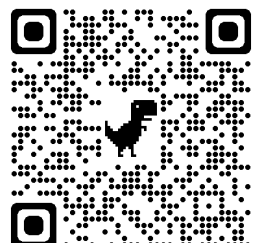
