







I first explore the connection between us living in the 3D world and characters inside the 2D world. A chaotic city of characters with animal heads and human bodies (S2). Then, I emphasize difference between the two worlds using contrasting textures. A clay character–representing me–falling into a birthday cake made of cardboard (S6). Incompatibility of myself in the fictional world shown through the size difference between me and the world inside the book (S8-9). Textures that can only exist in utopian world (S10-11). Using elements from my childhood books, I designed book spreads of my own story (S13-15)






