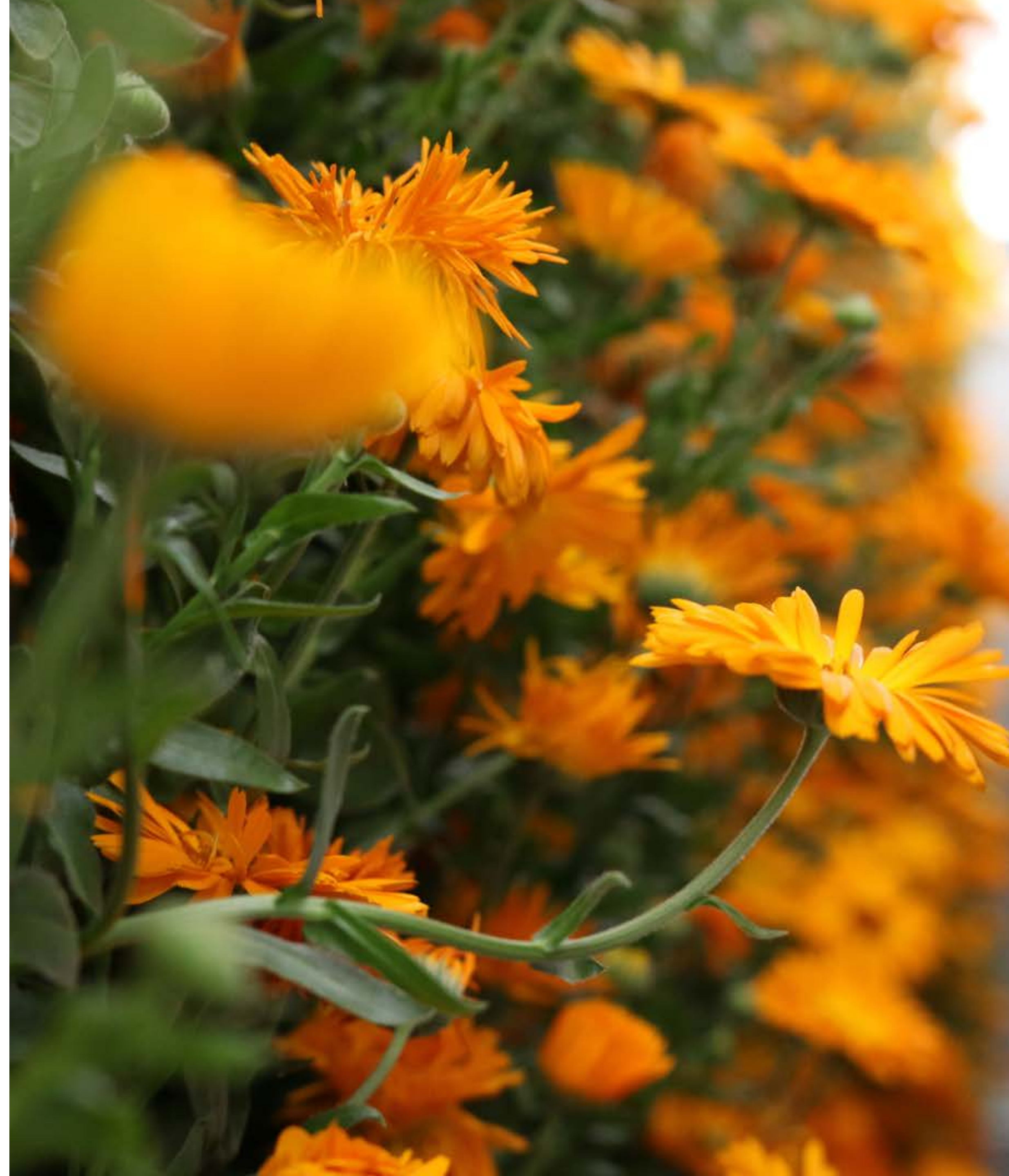
FLOWERS
