

AGE OF STUDENT RESPONDENTS




BACKGROUND TO THE REPORT






How many institutions will you apply to?




TOP FIVE MOTIVATIONS FOR STUDYING IN SPAIN

- 1 Ability to live & work in study location after graduation 43%
- 2 Experience of studying in location 41%
- Reputation of degree/institution 34%
- 4 Flexibility in studies (part-time work, internships) 22%
- Career opportunities in **home country** after graduation **20%**
- Cost of tuition 10%

POSITIVE OUTLOOK FOR EARLY 2022


85% of students in this survey said they wanted to begin studying within the next 12 months, indicating many students currently in research mode are further along in their journey to the classroom, ready to make a decision!

In some cases (33%), many of the potential students surveyed want to start as early as spring semester 2022.




60% of students said they needed funding to enroll
