The world has changed; however, our commitment to the health and safety of our guests and crew remains of the utmost importance to us. We want to reassure you that we are working with global health authorities and local governments in the U.S. and around the world to follow all the most up-to-date health and safety protocols, some of which we have summarized for you below. Our experienced staff and crew have undergone special training and will be advised and guided by a Public Health Officer. As always, our crew will be on hand to take care of all the details so you can relax and enjoy your much-anticipated river cruise vacation.

AMAWATERWAYS VACCINATION REQUIREMENT: Effective immediately, AmaWaterways will only be welcoming fully vaccinated guests on board our ships. Guests affected by this decision should contact their travel advisor for options to reschedule their river cruise.

ONLINE HEALTH
QUESTIONNAIRE

Pre-Cruise

Prior to boarding, an online Health and Contact Tracing Questionnaire will be required. You will be asked to upload your vaccination card and complete this form within 7 days prior to departure. Please note: Boarding will be denied without completing this form prior to your departure.



TEMPERATURE
CHECKS

Embarkation

At embarkation and every morning, guests' temperatures will be taken with no-contact infrared thermometers. If, for any reason, further testing is required, shoreside medical treatment centers are within close proximity.



SANITIZED
LUGGAGE

Your luggage handles will be sanitized before delivery to your stateroom.



FACE
COVERINGS

On Board

At this time, all guests are required to wear face coverings when moving through interior spaces on the ship and while using public transportation on shore, including on our motorcoaches. We strongly recommend packing medical grade and/or N95/KN95 masks, as certain countries and sites we visit require their use. For your convenience, our onboard gift shops fleetwide will offer a limited supply of medical grade masks at a cost of two euros per pack of five; and N95/KN95 masks at a cost of two euros per individual mask. These masks are also widely available in local shops throughout Europe.



CLEANING &
DISINFECTING


We will have ample hand sanitizers available throughout the ship and their frequent use is required by all guests and crew.

Our crew has implemented enhanced cleaning and disinfecting measures throughout the ship.



CLEAN
AIR

We use state-of-the-art fan coil air conditioning units; there is no recirculating of air among staterooms.



SOCIAL
DISTANCING

There will be limitations to the number of guests allowed to sail with us.



SAFE
DINING

Safety and social distancing will be enhanced throughout our dining room.



EXERCISE &
WELLNESS

You will still get plenty of fresh air and exercise as our bicycles, fitness mats and equipment will be thoroughly sanitized after each use. Use of the Fitness Room is by appointment with cleaning time between use.

Throughout Europe and Asia, we provide a variety of onboard wellness activities led by professionally trained Wellness Hosts. Whenever weather permits, these small-group classes will be held on our spacious open-air Sun Decks.

SOCIAL-DISTANCE
TECHNOLOGY

Your personal portable Quietvox commentary systems will allow you to hear guides while social distancing.



EXPLORING
ASHORE

Shore excursions will be conducted in small groups. Guests must use hand sanitizers when getting on and off our coaches that are thoroughly cleaned each morning.

In addition, masks will be required for all guests when using public transportation on shore, including our motorcoaches. Masking requirements vary by country and sites visited; please be prepared to bring your medical grade mask with you on all excursions. Some countries may require N95/K95 masks.

In the event that ships are docked side by side, guests will be required to pass over Sun Decks.

CLEARANCE

Pre-Cruise

Pre-boarding medical test and isolation periods, in-depth health and safety training, face coverings and social distancing are required. All of our crew have also been fully vaccinated against Covid-19.



CREW
TRAINING

On Board

All our crew have participated in in-depth training on enhanced operating protocols led by our experienced corporate Designated Hygiene Officer in consultation with international and national health authorities. Each ship has their own Public Health Officer overseeing all aspects of health and sanitation for guests and crew.



TEMPERATURE
CHECKS

Health will be monitored for potential symptoms as well as through twice daily temperature checks.



FACE
COVERINGS

Crew will be required to wear face coverings during working hours and continue to respect social distancing in their living quarters.
