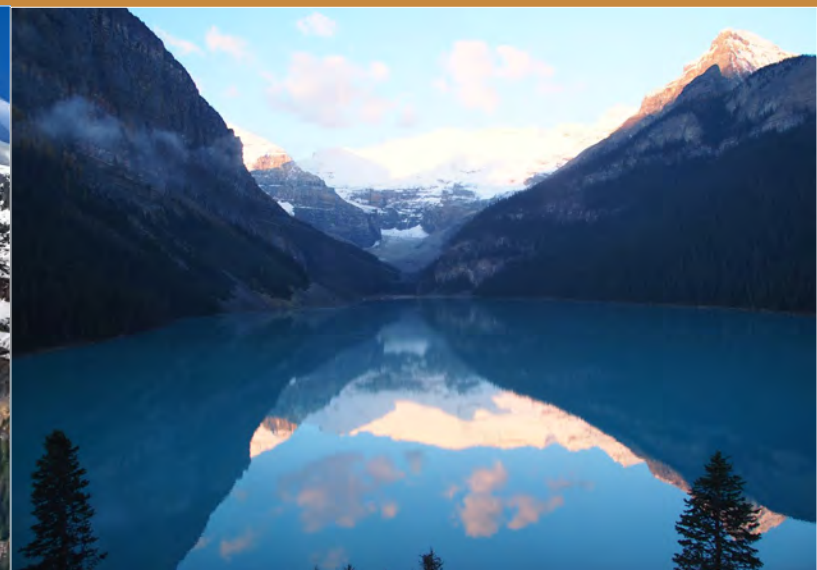
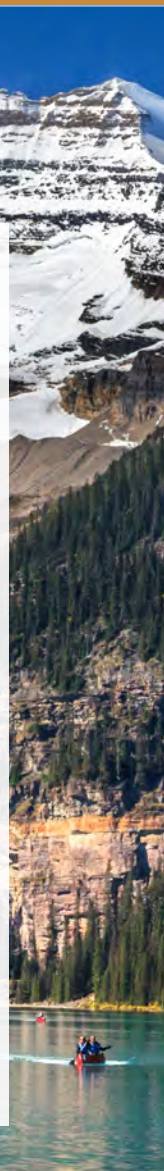
Sunday, September 11, 2022 | Calgary/Lake Louise

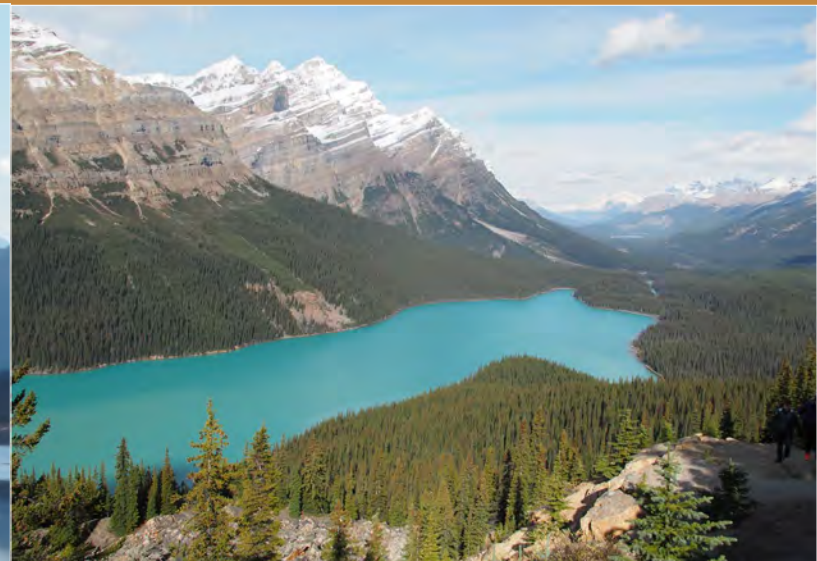
Tuesday, September 13, 2022 | Lake Louise/Jasper

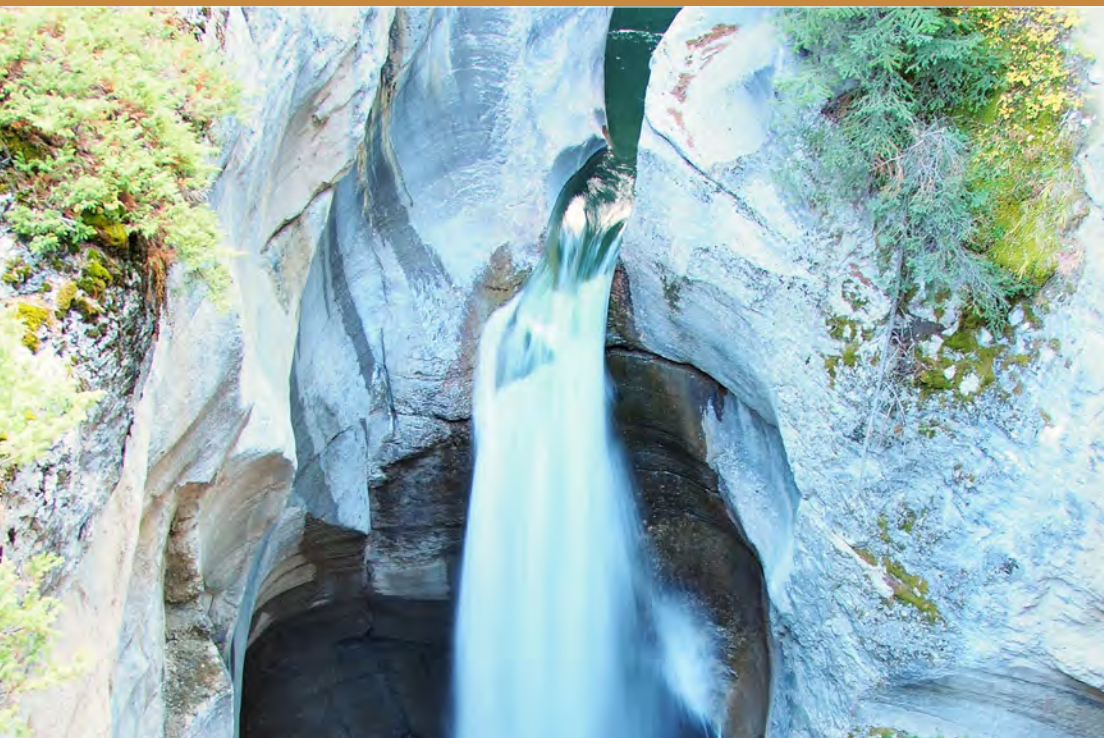

Your evening begins with dinner at a local restaurant then, along with your local guide, head out in search of bear, elk, mountain goats, bighorn sheep, and other alpine creatures. FLIGHTS

Arrivals: All flights arriving into Calgary (YYC) on September 10, 2022 should arrive no later than 4 pm. Transfers are on your own to the host hotel. Taxis from the airport are approximately \$40-\$45 CAN. We will have a meet-and-greet gathering at the hotel in the early evening.

Departures: A group motorcoach transfer is included on September 17, 2022. You will be transferred directly from our hotel in Banff to the Calgary Airport at approximately 9 am. Please choose a flight that departs from Calgary (YYC) after 1 pm. The drive time from Banff to Calgary is 1½ to 2 hours.
