



***Wind Star* is a sleek, 4-masted sailing ship accommodating 148 guests, made for pulling into secluded beaches, where the big ships can't go.**



Quepos, Costa Rica

Sunday, January 16, 2022

The former banana-exporting town of Quepos is your base camp for a day of rainforest adventure. Take a walk along trails that weave up to waterfalls, or ride horseback to a beautiful jungle pool. A float trip through a mangrove swamp populated by monkeys, crocodiles, egrets, and herons is also available. Or you may choose a nature walk through Manuel Antonio National Park, with its lovely beaches, easy trails, and abundant animal life.






Puerto Jiménez (Golfo Dulce), Costa Rica

Monday, January 17, 2022

Picture Jurassic foliage growing down steep hillsides all the way to the waterline, the hoots of monkeys echoing through trees choked by orchids. Golfo Dulce is one of Costa Rica's most biodiverse areas, where both the jungle and the sea brim with life. Explore the canals by kayak in search of javelinas, butterflies, and more bird species than in all of North America.



Isla Parida, Panama

Tuesday, January 18, 2022

Located within a nature preserve of 50 islands, and part of Chiriqui Marine National Park, lovely Isla Parida boasts magnificent white-sand beaches, one of which is over 1,300 feet long. The crystal-clear waters stay at 82 degrees year-round and are filled with marine life. There are numerous hardwood trees like teak, mahogany, and eucalyptus, and fruit trees like mango, banana and coconut trees. Here you will be treated to a delicious barbecue hosted by Windstar on a secluded beach that faces the Pacific Ocean.






Balboa/Fuerte Amador, Panama

Thursday, January 20, 2022



At nearly 48 miles long, the transit through the Panama Canal will include three sets of locks that will raise and lower our vessel 85 feet between the Pacific and the Atlantic. Your voyage features a daylight hours transit with numerous observation vantage points for outside and indoor viewing.





ACTIVITY LEVEL

The entire trip requires a moderate level of mobility—walking on rocky, sandy, or uneven terrain, gentle hiking uphill, and getting in and out of tenders (small boats) on steep stairwells from the ship and on shore. Please note that there are no elevators on board, and each deck is accessible by stairs only. If you have limited mobility and would require assistance to move about the ship or go on any of the excursions you decide to take, you are required to travel with someone who can assist you.

Flights should arrive in **San José, Costa Rica (SJO)** by 11:45 am on January 15, 2021. Flights should depart out from **Panama City, Panama (PTY)** no earlier than 12 pm on January 22, 2022.
