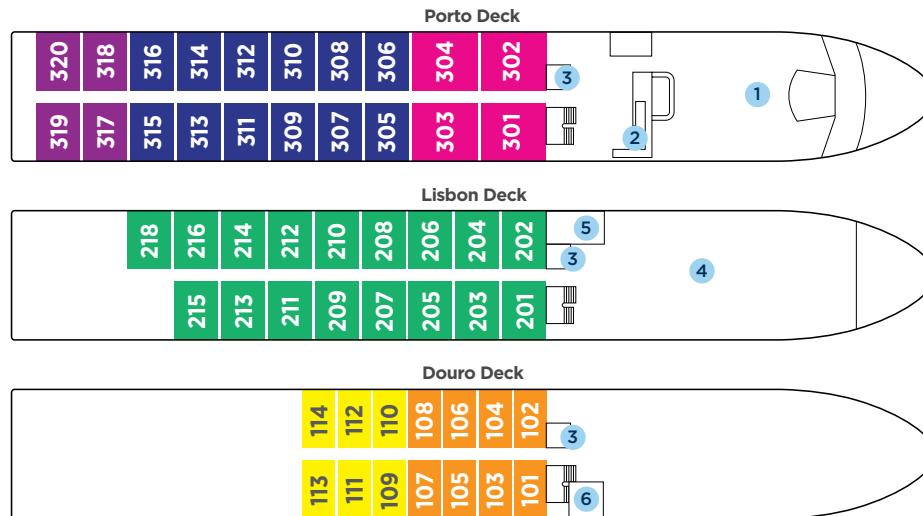

Fitness room Are you looking for a way to stay fit on vacation? Hit the treadmill or lift some weights while cruising from one destination to the next.

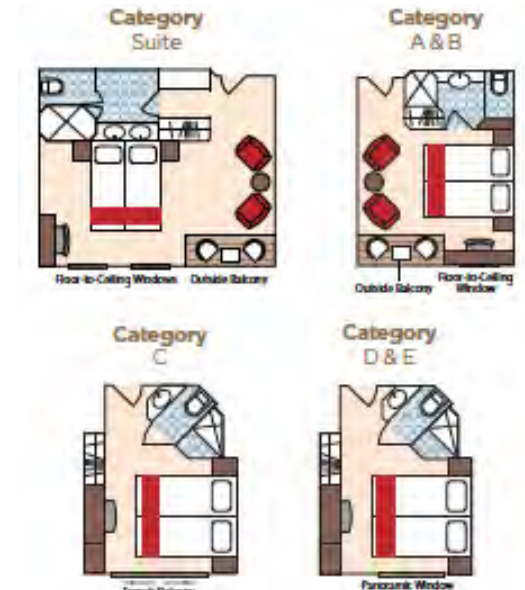
AMADOURO

RÉGUA AND PINHÃO



Monday, April 4, 2022

Today we will travel to picturesque Lamego, home to one of the most important pilgrimage sites in all of Portugal, where you'll go to the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios (Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies). The shrine features a staircase of nearly 700 steps, beautifully decorated with white and blue tiles, which the more active adventurer will want to climb on a guided hike. Concluding both tours, you will have the opportunity to sample local traditional specialties, such as *bôlas de Lamego*, bread filled with smoked ham; *presunto*, a type of dry-cured ham; and *Espumante*, a Portuguese sparkling wine. You'll then go to the formal Episcopal Palace Museum. Later in the day, savor the flavors of Portugal's renowned fortified wine, *vinho do porto*, made exclusively in the Douro Valley. Head to a local quinta for your authentic Port-wine tasting experience and enjoy the sweet nectar of this fascinating region. (B,L,D)



VEGA DE TERRÔN AND SALAMANCA

Tuesday, April 5, 2022

We will drive to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built of golden sandstone, Salamanca is known as a “living museum,” and you will have an opportunity to step back in time to the Middle Ages during your escorted tour, which includes the city’s elegant university buildings, the New Cathedral, the intriguingly decorated House of Shells and Plaza Mayor. BARCA D'ALVA

Wednesday, April 6, 2022

This morning we'll visit Castelo Rodrigo, a small fortified village perched high on a hilltop with centuries-old walls, steep narrow streets, and fantastic views. You can also opt to hike up to the village should you wish a more active exploration. We'll stop in sleepy little Pochino before reboarding our ship to enjoy the vistas as we cruise to Pinhão. This evening we'll dine at Quinta da Avesada, a 100-year-old winery, where we'll enjoying an authentic, traditional dining experience—complete with entertainment. Quinta da Avesada is also a fascinating interactive museum commemorating the history and culture of wine in the Alto Douro region, so you'll have fun discovering all the various stages of wine production as well as doing plenty of tasting. *Castelo Rodrigo tour with tasting of regional fare OR Castelo Rodrigo hike with tasting of regional fare. Quinta de Avesada dinner. (B,L,D)*

Thursday, April 7, 2022

Entre-os-Rios translates to “between the rivers,” and this small village is, quite appropriately, located at the confluence of the Tâmega and Douro rivers. This tranquil village offers an authentic slice of Douro River life. In the afternoon, indulge in a traditional Portuguese lunch with your fellow travelers in Entre-os-Rios at a local quinta—a country estate—for a truly authentic culinary experience. (B,L,D)

Today we return to colorful Porto, with its UNESCO World Heritage Site-designated historic quarter. Choose to explore the city on an escorted tour including the cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments, and the São Bento Railway Station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history or, if you prefer to get more active, take a guided hike. Afterward, we'll taste of port, Portugal's most renowned contribution to the world of wine. then enjoy a port wine-tasting. ACTIVITY LEVEL

This trip requires some mobility without the use of a wheelchair or scooter, as most of the tours are walking tours for up to 3 hours, which may include walking on cobblestone streets and stairs. A 'Gentle Walkers' group is offered on most included walking tours, which accommodates those needing a little extra time and sometimes offers a shortened version of a tour, designed to encounter as few stairs as possible.

If you are bringing a portable wheelchair or collapsible travel scooter, you must be able to collapse it and store it in your cabin. It cannot be used to get around the ship, only while off the ship on tours that are wheelchair/scooter accessible. On tours, the usefulness of a portable wheelchair or scooter may be limited because we will be navigating cobblestone streets with hard curbs (no curb cutouts) and stairs.

If you have limited mobility, you are required to travel with someone who can assist you.

FLIGHTS

All flights should arrive into **Francisco Sa Carneiro Airport (OPO)** in Porto, Portugal by 3 pm on April 2, 2022 to get to the ship in time for our orientation and evening plans, which begin at 5 pm. The airport is approximately 20 minutes from the ship's docking location. All guests should be on board by 5 pm.

If you plan to join us on a 1- or 3-night pre-trip Vacation Stretcher, you should fly into Humberto Delgado Airport (LIS) in Lisbon, Portugal and out of Francisco Sa Carneiro Airport (OPO) in Porto, Portugal.

All flights can depart **Porto (OPO)** at any time on April 9, 2022, because the ship will overnight in Porto on April 8. Transfer to the airport is on your own, but the ship will assist in making taxi reservations.



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
