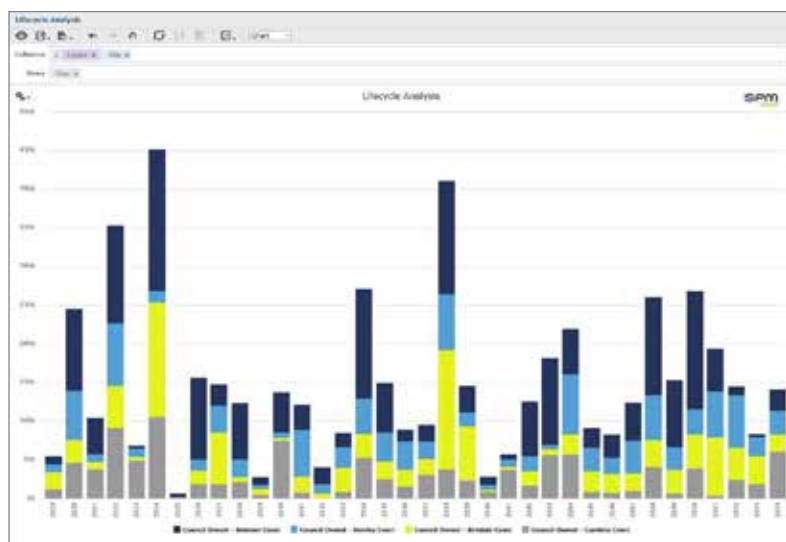

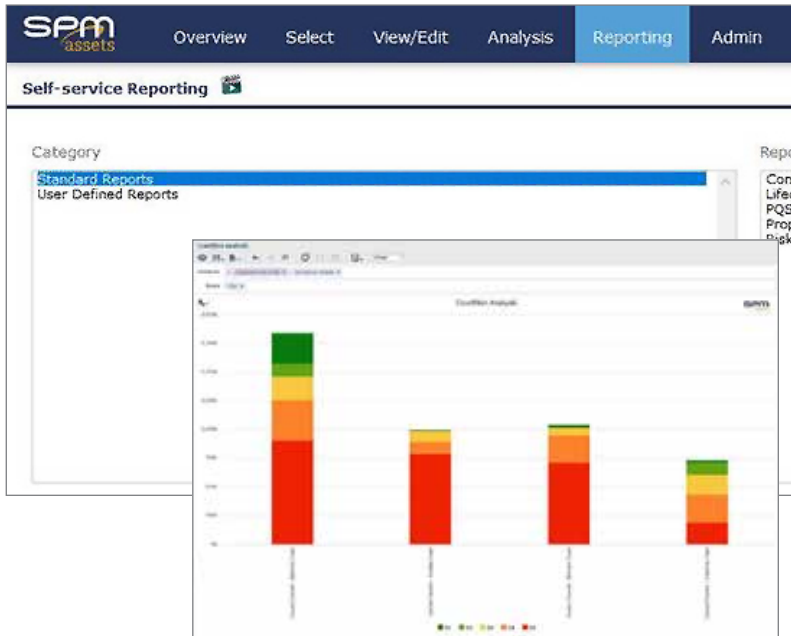


As standard

Within SPM Assets Software's Core System you receive a standard set of reports for properties, components, quality standards, work orders and lifecycle analysis forecasts. These all follow a common application selection criteria, within fixed formats, and can be viewed on screen, or downloaded as .csv or .pdf files.

Self-Service Reporting, commonly referred to as 'ad hoc reporting', gives you the ability to customise from a selection of pre-configured standard reports to achieve a specific outcome in graphical or tabular form including the condition of your portfolio and the associated lifecycle analysis forecasts. You can also create new reports that meet your organisations reporting needs. SPM Assets can configure more specific reports tailored to your data set, providing access to all users where appropriate.

Key features

- Our easy-to-use drag-and-drop report designer lets you build interactive crosstabs, tables and chart-based reports within SPM Assets.
- Sort and re-structure data to property level or component level to create your own personal reports for future use.

- Create different chart types and re-format labels, axis, data points.
- Filter on datasets specific to your reporting needs.
- Upload other data as overlays for benchmarking and comparisons.
