



**This is a short-list of both international and Ukraine-based foundations actively working on helping Ukraine.**

**International Committee of the Red Cross**

The ICRC has been working in Ukraine since 2014. The foundation's operations in the country are among the ten largest ICRC operations worldwide with a team of over 600 staff members. Working closely with the Ukrainian Red Cross Society, the foundation is increasing their response to the humanitarian needs in Ukraine.

**Ukraine Humanitarian Fund**

The Ukraine Humanitarian Fund (UHF) was established in February 2019 to help meet the most critical needs of the conflict-affected population in eastern Ukraine, which might otherwise remain unaddressed.

**Ukraine Crisis Relief Fund by GlobalGiving**

All donations to the Ukraine Crisis Relief Fund will support humanitarian assistance in impacted communities in Ukraine and surrounding regions where Ukrainian refugees have fled.

**Nova Ukraine**

Nova Ukraine is a non-profit organization dedicated to raising awareness about Ukraine in the US and throughout the world and providing humanitarian aid to Ukraine. Since December 2013 Nova Ukraine have collected over \$3.5M in donations.

**Razom for Ukraine**

Razom was born out of the Revolution of Dignity in 2014 when millions of people worked together and risked their lives to build a pathway to a better future for Ukraine. Today, the organization helps provide urgent help and support in face of an extreme and unforeseen situation in Ukraine.

**Voices of Children**

Created in 2015, the Voices of Children Foundation has been providing psychological support to children affected by war in Ukraine through art therapy, video storytelling, mobile psychologists and more.
