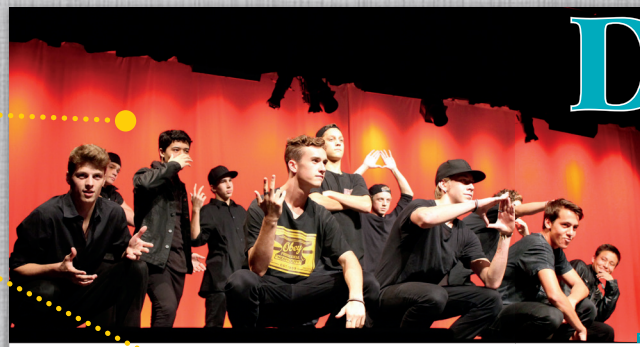


# EVENT EXPERIENCE
