GRADUATE SURVEY REPORT

Purpose:

The overall purpose of the survey was to understand the long-term impact of Summit Student Conferences on graduates over the last number of years. This survey sought to broadly "update the results" of a similar study (Turning The Tide) that was completed in 2012, demonstrating that Summit's Student Conferences have a highly significant influence on student's biblical worldview, spiritual disciples and life habits.

Process:

Email invitations were sent by Summit to those graduates where contact information was available (approximately 13,000 individuals). Invitations were emailed twice and text invitations were also sent to 800 individuals where that information was available. In addition, Summit placed notices through their Social Media platforms about the survey. Free access to selected Summit resources was also provided as an incentive for taking the survey, along with entering the individuals into a drawing for gift cards. Following are the overall response statistics:

- Total of 675 survey participants (maximum number that started the survey and completed at least one question) for roughly a 5.2% response rate
- Total of 477 individuals completed the entire survey

Assessment Categories:

In order to provide a better level of understanding of the survey results – especially as it relates to what the scores mean for the organization overall (consolidated results) – the following assessment categories are used for each of the Lickert-scale questions:

STRENGTH: the combined score of Strongly Agree and Agree is 70% or greater.


WEAKNESS: the combined score of Strongly Disagree and Disagree is 25% or greater.


AREA OF CONCERN: the scores rank between the Strength or Weakness parameters.

For each chart, the consolidated result is reflected as a color bar and if a particular segment has a different overall assessment score, it is shown as text in the appropriate color. For example, the following shows the consolidated result as a strength (the color bar), but for those that are 35+ years old, it was rated as a weakness (the colored text), as well as for those that attended 2 or more times. For those that have utilized Summit's curriculum, it was rated as an Area of Concern.




1. If you attended, what is the approximate year you first attended a Summit Student Conference?









3. What is your gender?





4. What is your age?









6. Have you ever utilized a Summit Curriculum?







61. Have conversations about politics




