Gatewatcher Certified **Security Professional** (GSP)

Duration : 1 day

Targeted audience : Technical profile from Technician to Manager

Prerequisites : Knowledge of network and computer security

Objective : Allow a person that has never used Trackwatch to understand what the product can do and how to use it on a simple basis

Duration : 2 days

Targeted audience : Technical profile, solution admins and advanced users

Prerequisites : GCSP and expertise in networking, hardware administration, or security

Objective : Enable a person to understand and use all Trackwatch features, and even to manage and configure it in its entirety.

Content : More than a dozen use cases or administration scenarios allow students to confront numerous use cases, and to manipulate all the functionalities and parameters

Gatewatcher Certified **Security Analyst** (GCSA)

Duration : 2 days

Targeted audience : Cybersecurity expert, SOC analyst, probe operator

Prerequisites : GCSP, network and security expertise

Objective: Enable an analyst to understand how to best leverage Trackwatch to detect threats

Content : Multiple attack scenarios allow students to manipulate Trackwatch in realistic situations to understand in detail how to detect threats and conduct end-to-end investigations
