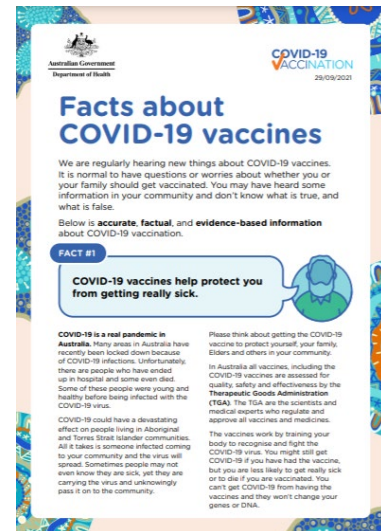

Make sure you get your flu #vaccine, as well as both doses of your COVID-19 vaccine, to be most protected.

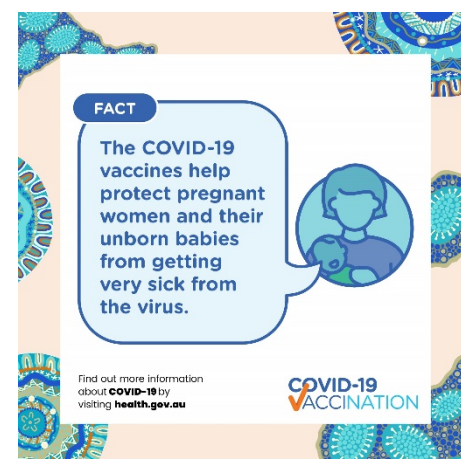

The COVID-19 #vaccine will help protect you and your community from getting really sick. Vaccines are available for everyone in Australia aged 12 years and over.

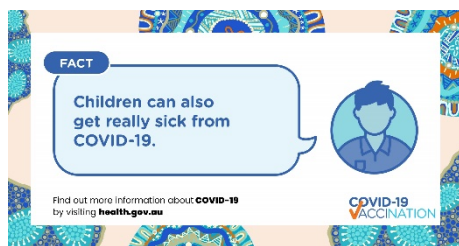
