

Job Title: Seasonal Lifeguard

Compensation: Starting \$14.77hr

MUST BE AT LEAST SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF AGE.

Job Summary:

Under the direction of the Aquatics Director, the lifeguard is responsible for the enforcement of policies, rules, guidelines, and regulations governing the conduct of patrons using Central Park facilities. Position requires working evenings, weekends, holidays and requires ability to cover shifts at all Central Park Swimming Pools as needed

Essential Duties:

- Monitors activities in swimming pool area - prevent injuries and accidents.
- Rescues swimmers in danger of drowning and administers first aid.
- Performs related duties as required.
- Assists with and maintains records of activity levels and usage. Instructs or co-instructs programs and classes for various age groups and levels of ability.

Education, Experience and Formal Requirements:

- Must be at least sixteen (16) years of age.
- CPR certification, and Lifeguard Training certification are required by the first day of actual employment.
- Knowledge of current lifeguarding techniques and procedures related to rescue of drowning swimmers.
- Knowledge of first aid procedures common in swimming pool operations.
- Ability to act quickly and calmly in emergency situations by making proper judgments as to the correct course of action.
- Sufficient physical strength and conditioning to rescue swimmers in danger of drowning.
- Ability to enforce pool safety rules firmly and courteously with the public.
- Ability to demonstrate CPR and Rescue breathing skills within certification standards.
- Ability to work courteously with the public and staff while supporting safety, teamwork, and cooperation.

Certifications:

CPR certification, and Lifeguard Training certification are required.
