

Take the Drama Triangle quiz

The Drama Triangle, identified by Dr Stephen Karpman, is a dynamic model of social interaction comprising three archetypal (dysfunctional) personas – victim, persecutor and rescuer. They are trapped in a ceaseless cycle of conflict, switching between roles without resolution. Find out your default and secondary role by taking the following quiz.

Read the statements below and give each a score from 0-2 in the right-hand column, ie:

I do not identify with this statement0I identify somewhat with this statement1I strongly identify with this statement2	
A: I struggle to make decisions.	
B: I look for opportunities to help other people.	
C: I feel I am often unlucky.	
D: I tend to get impatient with my colleagues.	
E: My way is usually the right way.	
F: I regularly feel hopeless and overwhelmed.	
G: I hate it when I'm not in charge.	
H: I often feel responsible for other people's wellbeing.	
I: I'm told I can be intimidating.	
J: I don't 'suffer fools'.	
K: I'm generally a selfless person.	
L: Some people just don't have what it takes.	
M: I find it difficult to speak up for myself.	
N: I often speak up on behalf of others.	
0: I regularly feel out of my depth.	
P: I'm as likely to fight other people's battles as my own.	

Q: I am strongly empathetic.	
R: I like to help people solve problems.	
S: I always get landed with the worst projects.	
T: I rarely make mistakes.	
U: I feel guilty if others are struggling.	
V: I often feel undervalued.	
W: I avoid confrontation.	
X: I quite enjoy confrontation.	
Y: Helping others is a reward in itself.	
Z: I'm quite critical of other people.	
AA: I find myself picking up the slack for other people.	
BB: I expect others to meet the same standards I set for myself.	
CC: I don't feel I have any influence.	
DD: I find myself blaming others a lot.	

Add the scores for each statement, in the order given below, to get a total for each archetype:		
Persecutor score:	D, E, G, I, J, L, T, X, Z, BB	
Victim score:	A, C, F, M, O, S, V, W, CC, DD	
Rescuer score:	B, H, K, N, P, Q, R, U, Y, AA	

Results

If your score is between 0 and 6: this isn't a strong role you play.

If you score between 7 and 13: you sometimes fall into this role; it may be your secondary role.

If you score between 14 and 20: this is a primary role for you.
