### Introduction:

**Case Solutions® Hand Sanitizer Denatured Alcohol with Aloe and Vitamin E** is formulated for an ideal balance—with 70% denatured ethanol for efficacy and emollients for skin health. Alcohol-based hand sanitizers are recognized by the CDC as the most effective products for reducing the number of germs on the hands of healthcare providers.

Repeated use of soaps, detergents, and disinfectants can strip oils from the skin and lead to irritation and dryness. Aloe and Vitamin E are ingredients that help protect and hydrate skin. Hand disinfection with an alcohol gel hand sanitizer containing emollients causes less skin irritation and dryness of the hands than handwashing and can be an important part of your overall infection prevention strategy.

The CDC provides the following hand hygiene guidance to healthcare providers:

- CDC recommends using alcohol-based hand rubs with greater than 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol in healthcare settings.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizers are the most effective products for reducing the number of germs on the hands of healthcare providers.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizers are the preferred method for cleaning your hands in most clinical situations due to evidence of better compliance compared to soap and water.
- Hand rubs are generally less irritating to hands and are effective in the absence of a sink.
- Healthcare professionals should be provided with products that minimize irritant dermatitis associated with hand antisepsis or hand washing.

## Directions for Use:

- Place enough product on hands to cover all surfaces
- Rub hands together until dry



Apply the hand sanitizer on your palms.



Rub hands together, palm to palm and back of each hand.



Cover all surfaces until hands feel dry (about 20 sec).

## Storage Conditions:

- Store between 15°C to 30°C (59°F to 86°F) away from heat source
- Avoid freezing and excessive heat above 40°C
- Keep container closed when not in use

## Compatibility and Safety:

- When using this product, keep out of eyes, ears, and mouth
- In case of contact with eyes, rinse eyes thoroughly with water
- Keep out of reach of children
- If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away
- Stop use and ask a doctor if irritation or rash occurs
- No added dyes or artificial fragrances

- Flammable
- Keep away from heat or flame
