

REQUIREMENTS:

Participation includes a screening visit, up to six injection visits and up to two leukapheresis procedure visits.

SCREENING:

- Provide consent and undergo a health assessment including an arm/skin check, vital signs, weight measure, a finger-stick sample for hematocrit, a blood draw for human leukocyte antigen (HLA) testing, viral testing and complete blood count (CBC). Women will be required to take a pregnancy test as well.
- Information will be collected through questionnaires for you to complete including demographic and general medical information, current medication, recent medical and surgical history.
- You may also be asked to provide whole blood and urine samples for research purposes.

TESTING:

- Once a blood donation is taken, a sample will be tested for infectious diseases such as HIV, Hepatitis B & C and sexually transmitted infections.
- If your sample tests positive, your donation will not be used, will not be used and our medical staff will notify you.



If you complete only the screening visit, including provide the blood sample, urine sample and health information, you will be compensated \$25 for your time and effort.

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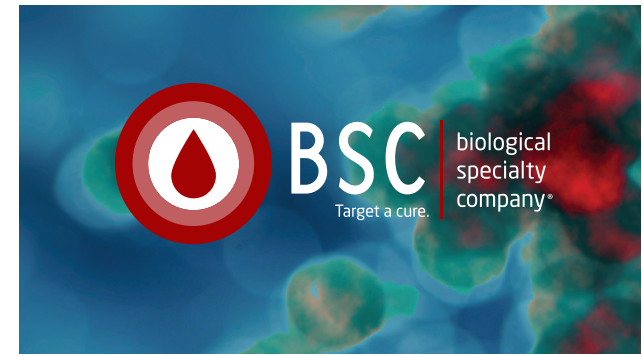
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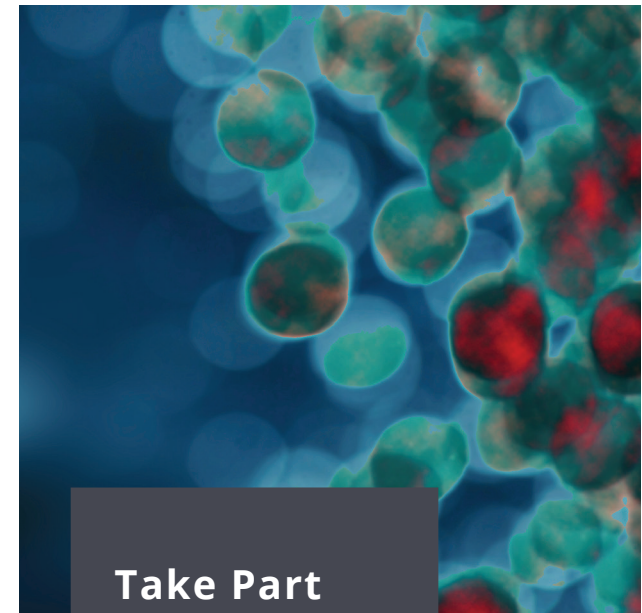

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MOBILIZED LEUKAPHERESIS PROGRAM

MOBILIZED LEUKAPHERESIS

This collection is a unique white blood cell donation. Prior to donating, injections of a bone marrow stimulating drug are administered, which boosts your body's white blood cell production. These injections are commonly used to mobilize stem cells to the peripheral blood for collection and subsequent autologous (originating from the recipient, not a donor) transplantation in patients with certain cancers.

If you qualify, injections and donations will be scheduled for you, based on the specific regimen for which you're participating.

If you agree to do a two-day collection (Regimen 2, 3, 4 or 5), but due to unplanned circumstances only complete one of the collections, then you will be compensated accordingly:

- Regimen 2: \$400
- Regimen 3: \$500
- Regimen 4: \$425
- Regimen 5: \$350

If you need assistance with travel and transportation to the donor center you may be provided a travel stipend.



NEUPOGEN® (FILGRASTIM) AND/OR MOZOBIL® (PLERIXAFOR) WILL BE ADMINISTERED ACCORDING TO EACH REGIMEN:

If you pass the screening visit and start a mobilization regimen, including providing up to 600ml leukocytes, you will be compensated as follows:

Regimen 1	Plerixafor/One-Day Collection	Compensation
Day 1	Plerixafor injection, approximately 10-11 hours before leukapheresis collection	Per injection visit \$50
Day 2	Leukapheresis collection	\$800
Regimen 2	Plerixafor/Two-Day Collection	Compensation
Day 1 & Day 2	Plerixafor injection once a day for two consecutive days. An evening dose given approximately 10-11 hours before each leukapheresis collection	Per injection visit \$50
Day 2 & Day 3	Leukapheresis collection procedure on two consecutive days	\$1,000
Regimen 3	Plerixafor & Filgrastim/Two-Day Collection	Compensation
Day 1 to Day 5	Filgrastim injection once a day for five consecutive days	Per injection visit \$50
Day 4 & Day 5	Plerixafor injection after receiving Filgrastim once daily for four days. An evening dose of Plerixafor given approximately 10 to 11 hours prior to each leukapheresis collection	
Day 5 & Day 6	Leukapheresis collection procedure on two consecutive days	\$1,200
Regimen 4	Filgrastim & Plerixafor/Two-Day Collection	Compensation
Day 1 to Day 5	Filgrastim injection once a day for five consecutive days	Per injection visit \$50
Day 4	Plerixafor injection after receiving Filgrastim once daily for four days. An evening dose of Plerixafor will be given on Day 4, approximately 10 to 11 hours before the first leukapheresis collection	
Day 5 & Day 6	Leukapheresis collection on two consecutive days	\$1,050
Regimen 5	Filgrastim/Two-Day Collection	Compensation
Day 1 to Day 5	Filgrastim injection once a day for five consecutive days	Per injection visit \$50
Day 5 & Day 6	Leukapheresis collection on two consecutive days	\$900
