



How to pay an invoice using MazumaGo

What is MazumaGo?

MazumaGo is a secure, no-limit online payment processing company for B2B payments. Funds are transferred directly between bank accounts, similar to a wire transfer or eTransfer but with added security and specifically built for business transactions.

How to pay an invoice in less than 1 minute:

NOTE: You are not required to sign up for MazumaGo and you won't be charged for accepting any payment requests.

1. Accept payment request

You will receive an email or a unique payment link along with your invoice. Click the link or the 'Accept payment request'-button in the email to be brought to the invoicing company's payment page.



2. Login to your online banking

Select your desired financial institution, login to your online banking, and select the account you wish to make the payment from.



You also have the option to enter your routing information manually. Our system works with all Canadian banks.

3. Review and initiate the transaction

Review and accept the terms, enter the email you want your receipt to go to, and click "pay" to initiate the transaction.



The funds will be debited from your account shortly after and a copy of your PAD (Pre-Authorized Debit Agreement) will be emailed to you.

What's the benefit to me?

- Save time and money: Pay invoices within minutes - you are not charged for accepting any payment requests.
- Added security: Direct deposits are a highly secure payment method because funds are transferred directly between banking institutions.
- Improved reliability: Your payment will not be delayed due to unforeseen circumstances such as being stolen or lost in the mail.
