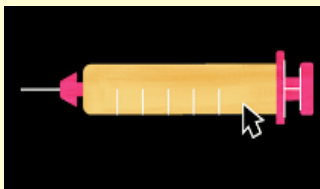


COVID-19 Vaccine Funding Grant Opportunity

Let's Stop COVID-19 Together

Dear Partners— The Administration on Community Living (ACL) with funding in partnership from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) awarded Washington State Disability Organizations funds to help our communities end the COVID-19 pandemic by increasing access to vaccine in underserved communities. These disability organizations are looking to provide funding out to non-profit organizations, for-profit companions, small businesses or government entities that serve people with disabilities in rural Washington areas or to organizations that serve underserved populations (Latin X, African American, Asian American, Homeless, LGBTQ+, etc.)



What are examples of allowable activities for this award?

1. Education about the importance of receiving a vaccine
- 2ž Identifying people unable to independently travel to a vaccination site
- 3ž Helping with scheduling a vaccine appointment
- 4ž Arranging or providing accessible transportation
- 5ž Providing companion/personal support
- 6ž Reminding people of the second vaccination appointment if needed, and/or providing technical assistance to local health departments or other entities on vaccine accessibility
