10 Questions to Help You Find Your Why



About the User(s)

- ▶ Who will be the primary user(s) of the bathroom? Will more than one person be using the bathroom at the same time?
- ▶ What activities will they be using it for (bathing, grooming, dressing, relaxing, laundry, etc.)?
- ▶ How is your existing bathroom hindering those activities?
- ▶ Do any users have physical limitations or other special needs?

- ▶ How are the limitations of your existing bathroom affecting you? Consider practical as well as emotional impact.
- ▶ In contrast, how would you describe what you hope to gain from your bathroom remodel?
- ▶ What words would you use to describe how you'd like to feel when using this bathroom? Example: "I'd like to feel unhurried and collected while preparing for my day."
