

Reopening Plan Phase 5

Easing Travel Restrictions for Children



What You Need to Know:

Who Can Travel

- ✔ All vaccinated travellers (*securely and non-securely verifiable*)
- ✔ Unvaccinated Caymanians, Residents and Work Permit Holders
- ✔ Unvaccinated visitors who have close ties to the country (*Persons who own local properties and businesses, or who are a spouse, civil partner, parent, step-parent, child, grandchild, step-child, or grandparent of a Caymanian or Resident*)
- ✔ Unvaccinated children under the age of 12 years old

Who Cannot Travel

- ✘ Unvaccinated tourist visitors (*including unvaccinated tourist visitor children age 12 years and over*) who do not have close ties to the country
- ✘ Unaccompanied tourist visitor children
- ✘ Cruise travellers

Travel Arrangements

- ✔ All travellers are required to apply on the Travel Cayman Portal and will be issued with a travel certificate which is required for entry (*apply no less than five days prior to departing for the Islands*)

Pre-Arrival COVID-19 Testing

- ✔ All incoming travellers age 5 years and over must provide a negative result from a PCR or certified antigen-detecting rapid diagnostic test (LFT) taken no earlier than the day before departure

Quarantine Period

- ✔ **10 days:** Unvaccinated travellers (age 12 years and over) along with all unvaccinated members of their household
- ✔ **10 days:** Unaccompanied unvaccinated children who travel from a country with a vaccination rate below 60% for the first dose of the vaccine quarantining with unvaccinated persons
- ✔ **7 days:** Unaccompanied unvaccinated children who travel from a country with a vaccination rate below 60% for the first dose of the vaccine quarantining with vaccinated persons
- ✔ **7 days:** Travellers with non-securely verifiable vaccination records who travel from a country with a vaccination rate below 60% for the first dose of the vaccine

Vaccinated household members are not required to quarantine but will be required to undergo a daily LFT for 10 days.

Children

- ✔ Unvaccinated children under the age of 12 years old will assume the vaccination status of their adult travel companions
- ✔ Unaccompanied unvaccinated children under the age of 12 years old will be subject to the 60% rule for rate of vaccination of the country from which they are travelling
- ✔ All children age 12 years and over are required to be vaccinated to be exempt from quarantine

Unaccompanied tourist visitor children are not permitted to enter.

GPS Tracking

- ✔ All travellers and their companions age 10 years and over who are approved to quarantine at a private residence

LFTs for Travellers Exempt from Quarantine

- ✔ Travellers who are not required to quarantine are required to undergo a certified lateral flow test (LFT) on **days 2, 5, and 7** (*3 tests in total*)
- ✔ Travellers testing positive using LFT will be required to have a PCR test administered at the next available testing time and adhere to Public Health isolation guidelines
