“Telephone Scam” phone calls from unknown callers still happen on a daily basis. **Telephone fraudsters, often impersonate legitimate organisations, will start overly friendly,** before becoming persistent and aggressive. They are after your personal information, so that they can steal your money or identity (or both). Promptly end the call and never share your information. **STOP.THINK.REPORT.**
