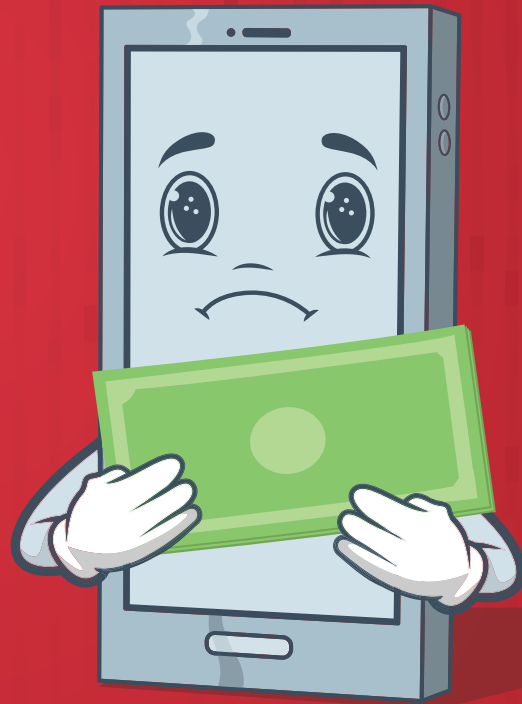


BETTER CYBER-SAFE THAN SORRY

Sextortion is a form of blackmail where someone threatens to share intimate images unless you pay.



“Online Sextortion and Blackmail” a scammer pretends to be a love interest, sending you deceptive revealing photos, maybe taken from other people’s social media accounts. They then ask for similar photos in return. Once the scammers have your sensitive photos or videos, they will blackmail you for money in exchange for not revealing to your family and friends. Never pay. **STOP.THINK.REPORT.**
