Following are tips and ideas provided by parents who currently invest in private Christian education for their children:





We started a 529 account for each of our children, anticipating college. By doing this, as we were paying our children's tuition in grades K-12 we were also saving toward their college education.





All profits made on a 529 account are tax-free and withdrawals can be made from the account to pay private school tuition."



Apply for need-based financial aid. This may be from the school or a private entity. One bank in our town had a scholarship set up by a customer for children who need educational funds.







Be proactive to understand and apply for the available financial aid programs. The business office will guide you in the financial aid process.





We make tuition a top priority each month, then budget around that amount for the rest of our family's needs.
