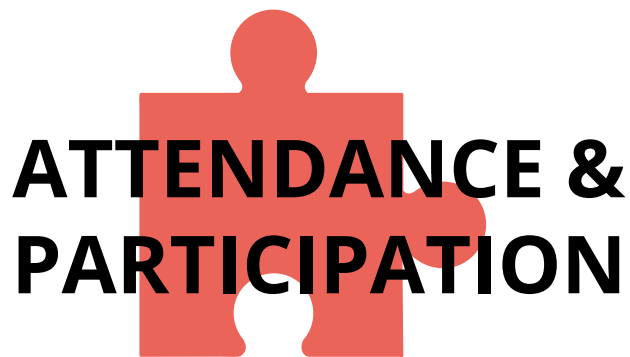

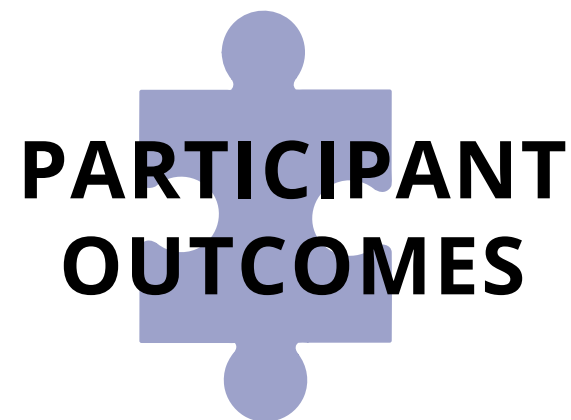
Our partners engage in data-driven continuous program quality improvement using the puzzle pieces below:
