How Does the SWB Diabetic Care Program Work?

- SWB Diabetic Care Program sends you simple text messages or automated phone calls to check in on your blood sugar and basic needs.
- You reply to messages and your responses go back to your SWB Care Team so they can reach out and support you when you need it most.
- You can receive messages or calls to your smartphone, landline, or basic cellphone.

How Do I Enroll?

In the coming weeks, you will get a phone call from 816-327-7411 or a text message to help you enroll in the SWB Diabetic Care Program.

Why Should I Enroll in the SWB Diabetic Care Program?

- Stay connected with your SWB Care Team between doctor appointments
- Your messages arrive at a time that you choose. It only takes a few minutes each week to respond to messages.
- Engaging with the SWB Diabetic Care Program *through text messages* helps you stay healthy from the comfort of your home.
- **SWB Diabetic Care Program is a free service. You will never pay for messages or phone calls!**
