# COMMON SENSE, DO YOU HAVE IT?



Most people use the tram safely and sensibly, but that doesn't mean we can't all benefit from a few simple safety pointers.

## YOUR TRAM YOUR SAFETY

Trams are one of the safest forms of public transport across the world. And that's how we want to keep it in Nottingham, where we carry thousands of people safely – commuters, shoppers, students and visitors – every day.

It's cool to catch the tram....taking your safety for granted certainly isn't!

For all young people, our message couldn't be clearer - don't put yourself and others at risk. Act responsibly.

### NET'S TABLE OF COMMON SENSE

	Never stand behind or in front of a tram.
	Always stand back when a tram is arriving or leaving a tram stop.
	Don't push people when getting on or off a tram.
	Wait for people to get off before trying to board.
	Don't cycle behind a tram too closely and never try to hold on to any part of a tram.

	Don't play or fool around at tram stops or on the track.
	Pay attention when crossing the tracks – use crossing points and keep looking and listening.
	Don't let yourself get distracted by mobile phones and headsets.
	Don't sit on the platform edge at a tram stop.
	Spare a thought for other tram-users and travel responsibly.



**REMEMBER...**  
If you see anything suspicious tell us by using the help points on the tram or tramstop, or by telling the police.

# LET'S BE CLEVER, IT'S NOT HARD.



There are some things you just don't do around the tram network, it really doesn't take a genius to think about what they might be either.



**Don't interfere with any line side equipment**



**Don't place obstacles on the rails**



**Don't throw stones or other objects at passing trams - people will get hurt**



**Don't climb near to, or put objects on, our overhead power lines**



## **REMEMBER, WE'RE ALWAYS WATCHING**

We always work closely with the police to tackle anti-social behaviour. The tram system has CCTV coverage. We record any incidents and share these with the police.
