First, (slightly early) happy Valentine's Day to everyone!

This was a very good week in Connecticut and here on the campus as the number of COVID-19 cases continued to plummet. Cases, deaths and hospitalizations all declined to the lowest levels we have seen since mid-November.

There have been 0 Resident or staff cases since February 2nd, and we hope to be able to stay that way (forever). This has allowed us to re-open many of our Resident activities. Our staff has done an incredible job working through this latest wave, and I certainly hope you take the time to thank them for their efforts and commitment! We also continue to actively recruit, and will be hosting another Career Fair on February 21st.

After a series of conversations and efforts, the CT House of Representatives extended most of the Governor's Executive Orders last night, and amended the deadline until March 7th for staff to be boosted. While we have greater than 90% of our staff boosted as of today, we are pleased that this extension will give others the opportunity to update their vaccine status.
