BATHROOM MEASURMENT GUIDE

Taking your own measurements doesn't have to be complicated. By taking this step now, we can save a lot of time and we can price your project more accurately. We've provided the graph paper, so grab a pencil and measuring tape and follow the simple steps below to get us started!

STEP 1 - Draw a Basic Outline of Your Existing Bathroom On The Graph Paper Provided


- > Draw the walls of your bathroom on the graph paper provided.
- Draw the Tub/Shower, Vanity, Toilet & closets

STEP 2 - Take Measurements of the Bathroom

- Measure the total length of each wall (corner to corner) and note it on the graph paper (round to the nearest 1/2" inch)
- Measure the location of each window & door opening measuring from outside edge of trim to outside edge of trim
- Measure from the corner of the room to center of the faucet(s), & toilets
- Measure the width of the vanity
- Note all electrical switches & outlets (Use the universal symbols guide below to mark each location
- Measure the finished ceiling height & note on drawing


STEP 5 – Take Pictures

- Take any additional pictures you think might be relevant / helpful




