

Survey from Hublet in Libraries, Finland

In Spring 2021





Survey Background

Hublet ran a survey among existing library customers in Autumn 2020, Finland.

A total of 65 library employees from Finnish libraries responded to Hublet's survey.

The survey asked about how Hublet Solution is applied to these libraries and how hourly wages and working hours of library staff are calculated for the results.







About the Subscription of Physical Newspapers and Magazines



said that their library orders of those decreased during the last year.

- → More than half said the reason was the transition to digital material.
- Of the libraries which have switched to more digital materials, 42% said the Hublet Solution has replaced physical newspapers.










Survey from Libraries in Finland, Spring 2021


