Pathogen control expert Anitox has confirmed significant increases in investment in technical services to support the poultry industry's 'safer food' commitments.

Anitox President and CEO Dr Rick Phillips explains: "As food safety continues to challenge our industry, Anitox is stepping up to the plate and investing in the technical competency needed to move everyone forward.

"We're seeing a shift in emphasis from both poultry meat producers and the commercial layer sector, with efforts increasingly focussing on the relationship between biosecurity in live production and salmonella and campylobacter rates in processing plants. The investment means one-in-10 Anitox colleagues join the new Global Technical Team under the direction of chief science officer Dr Kurt Richardson. Simon Carlton (EMEA), Ratchai Leethochawalit (AP) and Jose Ramirez (US and LATAM) are promoted to newly created roles as Technical Directors, and Richard York becomes the company's first Director of Application Technology. Laboratory, feed technology and data management colleagues complete the line-up.
