- Assist in content programming
- Provide quality control for all in-arena television content
- Ensuring all IPTV endpoints are on and functioning properly prior to scheduled events

- Basic knowledge of distributed video systems, especially Triple Play and or Cisco IPTV systems
- Experience in scheduling software and spreadsheets
- Experience in motion graphics, animation, Photoshop is a bonus

- Ability to balance multiple projects at once in a fast-paced work environment
