Who Qualifies

- Virginia residents who lost their job due to COVID-19 and received unemployment benefits on or after Aug. 1, 2020, **or**;
- Virginia residents who were laid off from a full-time job due to COVID-19 and now work part-time, earning less than \$15/hour.

Services Include

- Occupational Training
- Career Coaching
- Resume and Interview Assistance
- Access to Online Job Fairs
- Financial Coaching and Workshops

Training Information

- **You must apply by Dec. 8, and training must be completed by Dec. 29.**
- Training costs must not exceed \$1,000; participants may choose to cover the remaining cost should it exceed the limit.
- Training must focus on the following industries: health care, information technology, skilled trades, public safety, and early childhood education.
