

Case Study

Dural Public School (Dural, NSW)

Brief

This eating area at Dural Public School needed shade as it was a high use area and often had children sitting around for long periods of time in the sun. The school was keen to install a shade sail that would last, and they also wanted to ensure that the structure fitted in with the existing look of the school.

Approach

In consultation with the school our team designed a 10m x 10m premium hypar shade sail which was positioned to provide the maximum amount of shade throughout the school day. The fabric is from the Commercial 95 Shade mesh range and has a 10-year warranty. The fabric provides excellent UV protection, and its knitted lock-stitch construction makes it fray and tear resistant as well as offering more air movement and better channelling of cool breezes.

Outcome

The spaces is great as a multi purpose area, whether it be used for classes to get outside on a beautiful day (when it hasn't been already taken by another class!) and enjoy the fresh air, or as a spot for kids to socialise at lunch. The choice of a neutral colour scheme, grey and dark navy, ensures the finished project fits seamlessly into the area and won't date quickly, making it a great investment for the school and a stylish way to keep students from being exposed to harmful UV rays!
